

2011 Training for Responsible Packaging Management - SANS 10406 Reprocessing of previously certified packaging for safe, legal re-use



- **The UN Model Regulations require new and re-used packaging to comply with specific criteria to be suitable for use with liquids and the various classes of chemicals, and have a QA programme in place for consistency.**
- **New drums and IBC's have to be tested and certified to comply with specific performance tests**
- **The test certificate for drums is valid for 1 year when manufacturers must submit new samples for retest to confirm continued compliance. The certified mark must be applied to each unit showing this "birthmark" with manufacturers' certificate number and date of test, so that users can ensure suitability for their products.**
- **Similarly, and even more important reprocessors & reconditioners of packaging must ensure used packaging meets set criteria and is marked with the reprocessor unique mark & date for legal re-use.**

Responsible Packaging Management represented in SA by the RPMASA, is International Best Practice with a cradle to cradle approach for reprocessing of used drums & IBC's, SANS 10406 is SA Standard

The RPMASA supplies members with Guidelines and Codes of Practice, together with checklists to enable them to comply, an Audit protocol to measure compliance + a registration scheme for those who comply to be issued with a unique mark to apply to each unit reprocessed for legal re-use & an Auditor registration Scheme. Annual audit is required to retain registration
