



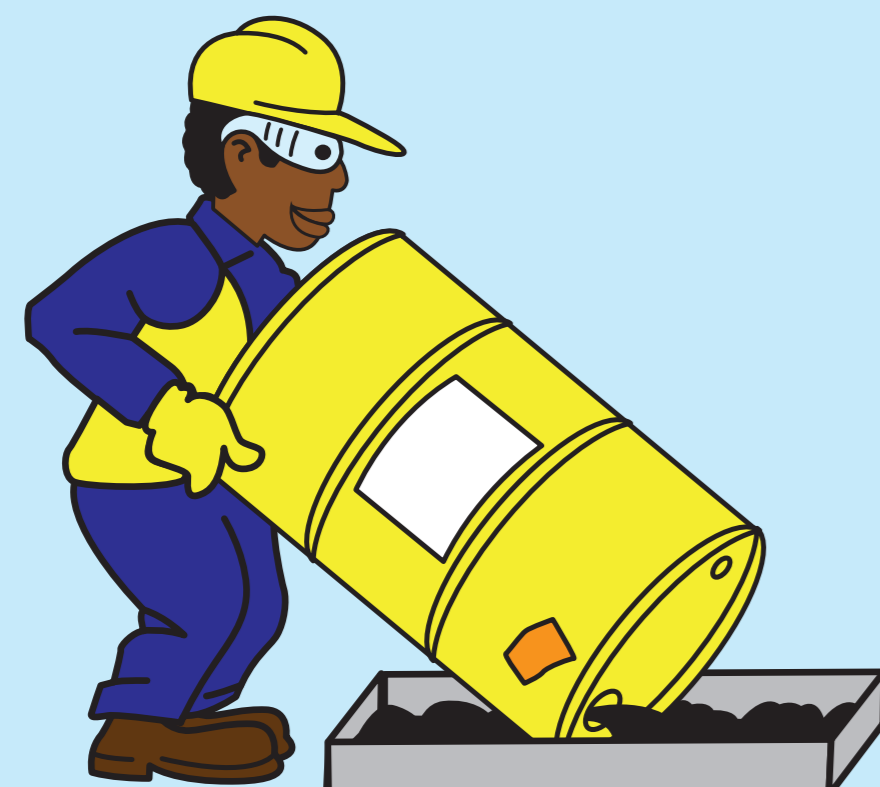

Pour out contents...

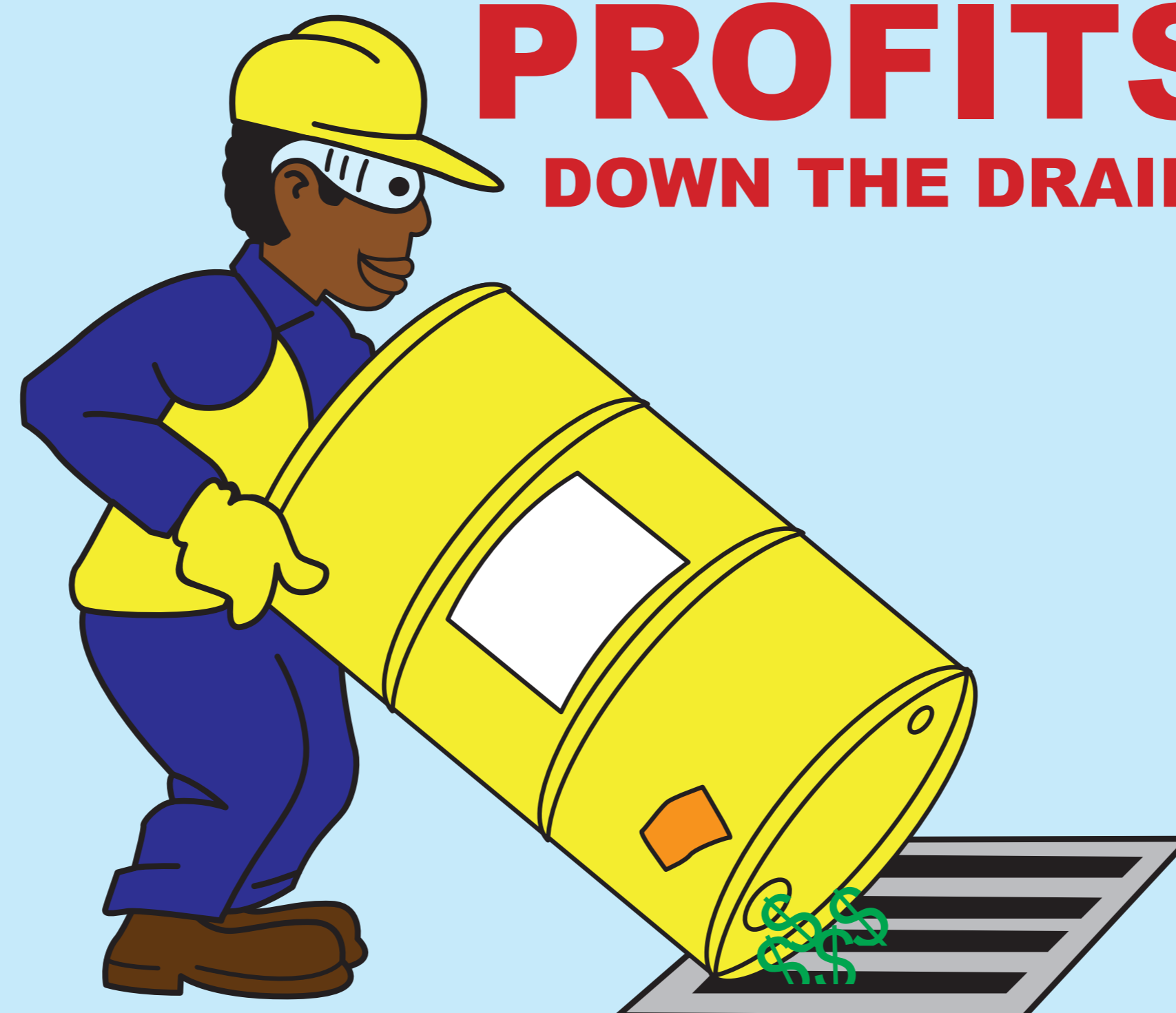


Until drip dry...



Replace and tighten all closures.

DOWN THE DRAIN!**

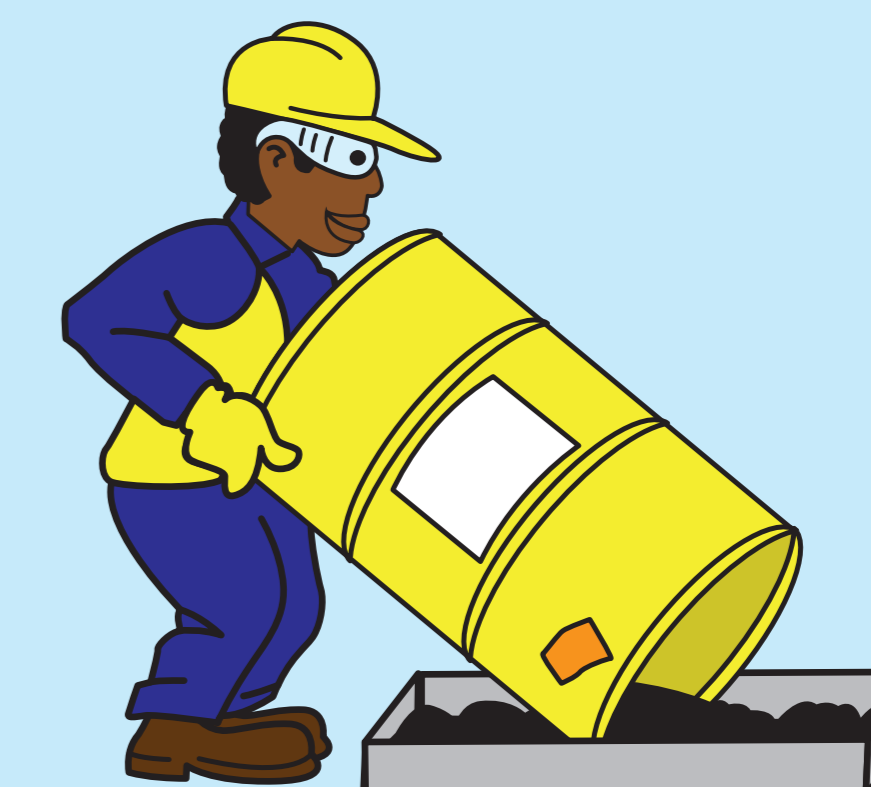


**Don't waste your valuable product
MAKE EVERY DROP COUNT!**

REMEMBER:

- **DO NOT REMOVE OR DEFACE LABELS.**
- **AN EMPTY DRUM IS NOT EMPTY IF PRODUCT CAN STILL BE Poured, Pumped or Scraped from it!**
- **ALWAYS STORE USED EMPTY DRUMS IN A SECURE AREA, READY FOR LICENSED TRANSPORTATION.**
- **DRUMS THAT HAVE CONTAINED CLASS 6.1 TOXIC PRODUCTS MUST BE TRIPLE RINSED & DRAINED BY THE USER PRIOR TO DESPATCH BY ROAD.**
- **THE "QUALIFIED" PERSON DESPATCHING USED DRUMS MUST BE TRAINED & COMPLETE A NOMINALLY EMPTY CERTIFICATE IN DUPLICATE TO ACCOMPANY THEM, PLUS RETAIN A COPY AS PROOF OF DESPATCH BY WHICH TRANSPORT, AND TO WHERE.**

FOR OPEN HEADS:



Pour, pump or scrape out contents...



Until empty...



Replace all lids and rings securely.
